



Level of Care: Vermont

BLS

- Oxygen (any method other than ventilator)
- Medication in the form of patch or paste applied to skin, if applied prior to transport
- Capped peripheral lines (no infusions at all)
- Some oral medications
- Nebulizer treatments

ALS (or AEMT)

- No cardiac monitoring
- No ongoing or anticipated medications to be administered unless otherwise contained in AEMT scope
- Peripheral intravenous administration of any crystalloid infusion
- Patient-controlled analgesic (PCA) pump
- IV Tylenol

ALS-P (Paramedic)

- Midazolam or Lorazepam
- Antibiotic maintenance (must be initiated by facility)
- Nitroglycerin, lidocaine, norepinephrine, Amiodarone infusions
- Fentanyl, Morphine
- Ketamine Infusions
- Blood products (initiated by facility)

SCT (paramedic with additional training)

- Heparin drips on pumps

CCP
